

House rules for the "Ferien-Kinderparadies" kindergarten for guest children

1. Conditions for admission

In principle all children between the ages of 18 months and 6 years will be admitted.

Each child must be enrolled in writing for insurance purposes.

Should there not be enough places free, those who are most dependent on the place will be given priority (e.g. single parents, families with emergency situations etc.).

Children with acute illnesses, for example contagious childhood illnesses, colds, temperatures etc are not allowed to attend the day nursery.

Other illnesses or any allergies to food or medicines etc should be mentioned in the space provided on the enrolment form.

2. Opening times

The nursery school for guest children is only open during high season: From Monday to Friday 9.00am to 5.00pm.

The day nursery is closed on Saturdays and Sundays.

To enable us to create a harmonious daytime routine for the children, we would like to have set times at which the children will be dropped off and picked up.

Children can be dropped off between 9.00am and 10.00am, and can be picked up again without having eaten lunch at about 12.00 noon.

The nursery school opens its doors again between 1.00pm and 2.00pm to allow children to be dropped off or picked up.

All children can be picked up from 4.00pm and at 5.00pm the day nursery closes.

If another person is to be allowed to pick the child up in place of the parents, or if the child is eventually to be allowed to leave the establishment alone, this should be communicated to the nursery personnel in writing.

3. Enrolment

Children should be enrolled at least one day prior to attending the nursery. Enrolment is always carried out in writing in the day nursery. No refund can be given if the child does not turn up to occupy a place that has been paid for and reserved beforehand.

4. Food

The day nursery provides lunch. Breakfast and an afternoon snack are to be brought by the children. No sweets of any kind are allowed!

5. Further conditions

Disposable nappies must be provided for children whose nappies will need to be changed during their stay at the day nursery.

Slippers or anti-slip socks are obligatory.

Replacement clothes are strongly recommended.

In order to alleviate homesickness, a soft toy may be brought from home.

The day nursery accepts no responsibility for clothes etc. that go missing.

We ask all parents to become familiar with the house rules, and thank them for their trust and good cooperation.
